The farm businesses change and evolve, but the land and buildings remain under the Trust stewardship. Our farms also rent land, so are vulnerable to changes in ownership. Visit Plaw Hatch and Tablehurst farms; you will experience and appreciate their unique character and beauty, as well as their individual ranges of produce. Both farms are a mix of livestock (horned cattle, sheep, pigs and poultry), arable and vegetable gardens, with Tablehurst giving emphasis on its onsite butchery and Plaw Hatch specialising in raw milk dairy. Each farm is a separate limited liability company with its own board of directors, with both farms wholly owned by the Coop.

In addition, the rich biodiversity present in both farms attracts wide-ranging interest from ecologists, nature photographers and conservation organisations. Biodynamic Agriculture is a holistic form of farming, that predates the modern organic movement, with sustainability and soil vitality as its foundation. A biodynamic farm respects and enhances Nature's timeless working principles and functions as a whole organism with farm animals are at the centre. Seasonally applied specific manure- and herb-based formulations (biodynamic preparations), encourage healthy soil microbe life, fertility, and ecological sustainability.
